Mobility Support Operations Squadron (MSOS)

The MSOS is comprised of Air Mobility Liaison Officers (AMLOs) and Expeditionary Air Ground Liaison Elements (EAGLEs) who provide air mobility expertise to expedite movement of joint personnel and equipment aboard Air Force assets.

The 621 CRW... America's only CRW

The 621st Contingency Response Wing is a unique, worldwide deployable organization whose forces are primarily stationed at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, N.J. and Travis Air Force Base, Calif. The 621 CRW consists of approximately 1,580 Airmen assigned to three groups, 13 squadrons and more than 20 geographically separated operating locations aligned with major Army and Marine Corps combat units.

Building Partner Capacity



Air Advisors train and assist partner nations in developing air mobility capabilities. Each MSAS is regionally aligned, but globally capable across the continuum from competition to crisis and conflict.

As the Air Force's enabler for joint maneuver, CRG forces execute airfield opening agnostic to follow-on mission, aircraft type, or partner force. CRG forces are "first-in" to open airfields and airbases. They are critical to bridging the gap between seizure and follow-on forces; initiating operations in minimal time at any location.
